Dear Praying Partners,

I hope this letter finds you well and enjoying the blessings of the Lord. In this unstable and uncertain world, it is good to know that *The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe.* (Prov. 18:10) Our Lord knows everything that is going on and everything that will happen in the future; we can rest in Him and His promises.

Even though the institutions are still closed to visitors, we have been able to take material and Bibles to several of them. In May, I was able to go to a jail and two prisons and take a lot of material in. Kay and I also got up several hygiene items to take to a women's prison. The chaplains and administrators were so grateful for us keeping in touch and bringing material and supplies. The inmates still need help, and still need to know that we love them and are concerned for their salvation.

In June, we went to our home office and worked in the print shop for a week, putting together booklets for the prisons. This is something we enjoy doing every year, and we were glad it could happen for us. I got to go to two more institutions to deliver material and Bibles. One of them is a prison that we are not in on a normal basis. Some of the inmates had been transferred to another prison, and when they saw our Bibles and material, they wanted us to come to their institution. The warden was very gracious, and we are going to talk about us getting in that prison when things go back to normal. God is working!

We also got to go to a private institution this past weekend in SC! We were thrilled when we got the call

that we were allowed in. It was a good meeting, with **3 souls being saved** during the 3-day revival. We only got services, no visitation, and wore masks, but we were glad to be there.

As churches begin to open back up, the Lord has allowed us to be back on the road some, which is very exciting. After I preached at one church, a man came up to me and said **I had led him to the Lord in 2014** at a prison in that area! He was rejoicing, and so was I!

In personal news, our garden is flourishing and we're busy canning/freezing. We've stayed healthy so far, praise the Lord. Our granddaughter is graduating from high school July 11, making us feel old! Please pray for her as she goes to college in the fall. Also, please pray for my mother, Bonnie McKinney. She is in a nursing home and is not doing well with being isolated for so long.

We're so grateful for your continued faithful support! God has truly blessed us, and we try hard to good stewards of all He gives us. We pray for you and appreciate your prayers as well.
