including our own, to help financially and help packing the bags; for this we are so grateful.

In December, we got to take barbecue meals to one of our local jails for the officers. Again, this was our pleasure and privilege. These folks have a very stressful job. We try to lift them up in prayer often, and hope you will too.

Then, I spent several days getting my FM transmitter going, getting all the components put together, and riding to the facilities to find the stations available. Praise the Lord, we have 4 broadcast meetings booked for January/February. Please be in prayer for these. We sure want to continue to get the Word out in any way we can.

God has been faithful to supply our needs, and we don't doubt He will continue. Would you please pray for our family, our churches & pastors, and our nation? We appreciate your prayers and financial support more than we can say. Praying God will bless you in a great way this year.
