Greetings brethren!

It is with great satisfaction that we write once again to share with you some of what the Good Shepherd has done through our ministry, and I emphasize **our** ministry, as I want to make it very clear that you are a part of this ministry. Without your partnership I am certain that we would not be able to be here.

The camp we had planned for last month actually happened. Although we are under various types of restrictions here in the state of Rondônia, the Lord permitted that exactly the week of our retreat there would be a relaxation of some rules and we were able to proceed with a high of 40 people present. Everything was wonderfully provided for by the Father, from the venue rented to the provision of meals for each day, to the messages preached. Our speaker was Pastor Mario Baio, a dear friend from Bible Institute days and a faithful pastor in his local church in Sao Paulo.

Our church has used a keyboard that we were given about 15 years ago. It was used when we got it, but it has functioned well. However, we began to pray that the Lord would provide us with a "real" piano. We prayed for about a year, and the LORD used our sending church in Simpsonville S.C. to provide us not only with an excellent piano for the church, but also one for our home.

Not that I have an evil spirit from God as in I Samuel 16:23, but I think I understand the relief Saul felt when he heard David play the harp, because it is wonderful at the end of the day to hear my wife play the piano in our home.

The brethren here continue enthusiastic. Although many are facing affliction of different kinds, most of them are involved in some way with the ministry.

We praise the SAVIOR that two young women, after four years of contact, prayer and visits, on the 15th of March confessed Jesus Christ as their only and all-sufficient Savior. It's wonderful to be able to lead souls to the Messiah, even during the pandemic.

Very soon we will have a distribution center for Bibles. We received a donation for the purchase of five thousand Bibles that will be given to any sister church that needs them.
