July was a busy month! The Lord let me go to **4 prisons** to do the radio services. At one prison, an inmate was standing at the fence during the whole service. He called me over and said, "More than anything, I want to be saved." I was able to lead him to the Lord from across the fence, and received a 6-page letter later expressing how grateful he was to know the Lord!

Kay and I were blessed to go to some new churches, and the Lord gave some new support. I dropped in a church on a Wednesday evening while working a prison, the pastor let me preach, and a 7-year old girl came forward and accepted Christ as her Savior! I traveled to Chattanooga for our annual coordinators' meeting which lasted 3 days, then on to the home office for meetings the rest of the week.

August brought the opportunity to go to **3 more prisons**. This month we had a **great need supplied** for our travels. We are so grateful for the people God puts in our paths who want to be a blessing to us as we do what God has called us to do. Praise the Lord for His goodness. We got to go to a couple of new churches and present the ministry as well.

We have been able to give out many cases of Bibles to the prisons and churches, and the First Responders New Testaments to police departments, fire stations, and places of business for them to give to their patrons who are first responders. We are using every

resource available to get the Gospel into the hands of people. We are getting letters from several of the inmates letting us know they are hearing the broadcasts. Praise the Lord for these opportunities!

Our church celebrated 60 years this month. Kay and I are the "oldest" members in terms of being at the church the longest. Kay has been a member for 51 years, and I have been there 49. In fact, we met there at Trulite Baptist Church, and I was saved there. What an honor to get to be at the same church that long. Our founding pastor, Bro. Paul Sparks, was a great influence in our lives. We both remember standing in front of the church as a young couple, making a vow to God that we would be willing to go anywhere and do anything the Lord asked. Now, we are honored to be missionaries with ROA.

We got to spend a couple of days at Kay's family reunion. I was able to take several cases of Bibles to the Sheriff's office in her home town, to be distributed to all the deputies, fireman, and police officers. We also went to one of our supporting churches, where I preached and updated them on the ministry.
