Dear Praying Partners,

Our Lord said in Rev. 22:12, *And, behold, I come quickly...and again in verse 20, Surely, I come quickly.* It is evident that we are in the last days, and the Lord is coming. That means we don't have much time to reach the lost. I trust that we all are busy trying to "bring them in" each and every day.

In May, we were able to go to seven churches, three of which we had not been to before. It was good to see that things are beginning to pick up more and more since Covid has slowed down some.

I was able to do **four prison meetings via the FM transmitter** in May. What a blessing to get letters and to be told in person by some inmates and staff that they appreciated us coming. God's Word will never return void! I was able to use local pastors to preach, and it was an encouragement to them as well.

We also spent a week at the home office, working in the print shop. We love doing that. Bro. David Harrelson and I met with the head chaplain in SC to discuss procedures for when we go back inside. I also had blue card training at one prison, and took Bibles to three different pastors who got them for their churches or to give to first responders. We logged over 3200 miles for May.

We were looking forward to our National Conference, which was held at the DL Moody Center in Massachusetts. We were scheduled to fly out, but our flight suddenly got cancelled on Friday night. We were getting packed and getting the van ready to drive on Saturday, and got a call that Kay's brother had passed away from injuries from his tractor rolling

over on him. The Lord knew we needed to be at home that week. We were able to immediately go to the home and help her sister-in-law. He was saved, praise the Lord, and had wanted me to do the funeral and the Lord blessed and helped in that. Please pray for some of the family that are not saved. We missed getting to go to Conference; we have been with ROA 15 years and have loved every minute of it.

We got to go to 6 churches in June, and I had **one prison revival**. A Spanish inmate stood in the yard by the fence listening to each service, and asked for a Spanish Bible. So, Kay and I rode back to that prison and took some Spanish Bibles for them. The warden said, "You mean you drove 3 hours just to bring these?" I told him it was worth it if that man read the Bible and got saved. I had another blue card training at a prison this month, and spent 2 days delivering more Bibles. The Lord is so good to let us stay busy for Him, and we are excited to see what is ahead.

Please continue to pray – officials have said the prisons might reopen to us soon. They have many details to work out, but we are trusting the Lord that we can go back really soon. Thank you for your continued support and prayers. God bless you.
